## SEATTLE STONEWORKS

Richard Rhodes's interest in stonework began with a masonry apprenticeship in Siena, Italy. Years later he founded **Rhodes, Ragen & Smith**—a favorite destination for **Jim Weinberg** and **Naomi Leff**—with his wife, Pamela Ottaviano Rhodes.

The company, which is located in a ca. 1900 carriage house in Seattle (above), offers everything from antique building materials to architectural ornaments and stone sculptures. The inventory at Rhodes, Ragen & Smith includes granite, limestone, sandstone and terrazzo that has been salvaged from ancient roads in China, Indonesia, France, India and Turkey.



"We're always working to preserve objects and stone that have been carved by the artisans who came before us," says Richard Rhodes. Rhodes, Ragen & Smith, 2011 E. Olive St., Seattle, WA 98122; 206/709-3024. □
